TRADE MISSION & ANNUAL JOINT CONFERENCE
TURKEY (ISTANBUL & ANKARA)
MAY 8 - 11, 2007

The Canadian-Turkish Business Council (CTBC) and its partner, the Turkish Foreign Economic Relations Board (DEIK), are holding their annual conference in Istanbul, Turkey on May 10, 2007. The conference is part of a **multi-sector trade mission to Turkey** that will take place from May 8 to 11, 2007, starting in Ankara and traveling to other major Turkish cities.

The mission and conference present a unique opportunity for businesspeople from both countries to meet senior contacts and to explore commercial initiatives and partnerships. The mission is aimed at senior executives of Canadian exporters and investors interested in the Turkish market. Mission activities will provide helpful information on doing business in this market as well as key priority sectors offering opportunities for Canadian firms, and will feature networking events with high-level government and business contacts vis-à-vis the CTBC's extensive network of contacts in Turkey.

Canadian exporters and investors from all sectors are invited to join the mission to Turkey.
